The student participates in the clinical reasoning process leading to a management plan.</p> <p><b>Observed (OB):</b> Student is present when the preceptor interacts with a patient. The student participates in the clinical reasoning process leading to a management plan.</p> <p><b>Alternative Experience (ALT):</b> Student was unable to access a direct patient experience and completed an appropriate alternative experience under the approval and monitoring of the clerkship director</p>

### OB-GYN Clerkship Clinical Learning Objectives

The EVMS Unified Competency Objectives (UCOs) were used to develop the clinical learning objectives. The EVMS UCOs are the governing objectives for the EVMS Medical Doctor Program. Please see the [EVMS website](#) for the complete list of UCOs.

1. Perform the medical interview and physical examination of women and incorporate ethical, social, and diversity perspectives to provide culturally competent health care.
2. Apply recommended prevention strategies to women throughout the life-span.
3. Recognize your role as a leader and advocate for women.
4. Demonstrate knowledge of preconception care including the impact of genetics, medical conditions and environmental factors on maternal health and fetal development.
5. Explain the normal physiologic changes of pregnancy including interpretation of common diagnostic studies.
6. Describe common problems in obstetrics.
7. Demonstrate knowledge of intrapartum and postpartum care.
8. Describe menstrual cycle physiology, puberty, and menopause and explain normal and abnormal bleeding.
9. Describe the etiology and evaluation of infertility.
10. Develop a thorough understanding of contraception, including sterilization and abortion.
11. Demonstrate knowledge of common benign gynecological conditions.
12. Formulate a differential diagnosis of the acute abdomen and chronic pelvic pain.
13. Describe common breast conditions and outline the evaluation of breast complaints.
14. Demonstrate knowledge of perioperative care and familiarity with gynecological procedures.
15. Describe gynecological malignancies including risk factors, signs and symptoms and initial evaluation.
16. Provide a preliminary assessment of patients with sexual concerns.

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
